

# MAX WOLFLEY'S LIBERAL VOTES

The 2025 OKGrassroots Republican Platform Scorecard gives Wolfley a 45.71% grade, with 2 missed votes.

Fact-check update: the OKGrassroots reference has been updated from 2024 to 2025, Wolfley's current score is 45.71%, and the construction-bidding bill is SB 898, not SB 98.

## Midnight Rule Suspension

Wolfley voted yes to suspend House rules on May 29, 2025. The vote received 68 yeas at 9:16 p.m., exactly the two-thirds threshold if measured against the full House membership.

HB1571, RCS#24

## Route 66 Spending Pipeline

Wolfley voted yes on HB1571, removing the expiration date of the Oklahoma Route 66 Commission and keeping an off-the-top program alive.

HB1190, RCS#433

## Non-Citizen Police Authority

Wolfley voted no on HB1190. The bill would have prohibited certification of permanent resident aliens as law-enforcement officers, with an exception.

SJR22-FA1, PROCEDURAL VOTE

## School Immigration Transparency

House video and the People's Audit list Wolfley as voting yes to table the proposal to track the impact of illegal immigration on public-school enrollment.

HB1664, RCS#827

## Open Meeting Act Loophole

Wolfley voted yes on HB1664, creating an Open Meeting Act exemption for certain county-commissioner conferences, trainings, events, and related matters.

SB898, RCS#631 AND #711

## Construction Oath Flip-Flop

Wolfley voted no on third reading, then voted yes to give immediate effect to the bill removing the under-oath disclosure requirement for certain public construction bidders.
